# Caregiver Support in Uppsala County

Information for those helping others



















### **Caregiver support**

As a caregiver you have the right to support. The aim is to reduce mental and physical strain on the caregiver.

The municipality is obliged to provide support in order to help individuals who provide care for a close relation who is elderly or suffering from a long-term illness or disability. This is set forth in Chapter 5, Section 10 of the Swedish Social Services Act. Support for caregivers must encompass all social service activities.

#### Who qualifies as a caregiver?

The term "caregiver" refers to anyone who provides care or support for another person. This may be, e.g., a child, sibling, parent or friend of individuals with mental or physical disability, long-term mental or physical illness, or individuals with substance abuse or addition problems. You are not required to live together with the person under your care.

#### **Examples of caregiver support**

- Information on options and terms for receiving support
- Supportive discussion
- Caregiver groups
- Counselling
- Training
- Respite care/Personal time
- Health-promoting activities

Caregiver support is free of charge and provided under professional secrecy!

#### How can you get help?
